

Note 1. (Note 2 of Rule 18(1) under CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964) : In this Form, information may be given regarding items like (a) jewellery owned by him (total value) : (b) silver & other precious metals & stones owned by him not forming part of jewellery (total value) : (c) (i) motor cars (ii) scooters/ motor cycles (iii) refrigerators/ air conditioners (iv) radios/ radiograms/ television sets & any other articles, the value of which individually exceeds Rs. 1,000/- (d) value of items of moveable property individually worth less than Rs 1,000/- other than articles of daily used such as clothes, utensils, books, crockery etc. added together as lumpsum.

Note 2. (Rule 18(3) under CCS (Conduct) Rule, 1964) : "Where a Government servant enters into a transaction in respect of movable property either in his own name or in the name of the member of his family, he shall, within one month from the date of such transaction, report the same to the prescribed authority, if the value of such property exceeds twenty thousand rupees in the case of a Government servant holding any Class I or Class II post of fifteen thousand rupees in the case of Government servant holding any Class III or Class IV post". The same should be reported in Prescribed Form 2 under Appendix V of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964.
