

NOTE : 1) (Note 2 of Rule 18(1) under CSS (Conduct Rule, 1964): In this form, information may be given regarding items line (a) Jewellery owned by him (total) value (b) silver and other precious metals and precious owned by him not forming part of jewellery (total) value (c) (i) Motor cars (ii) Scooter/Motor Cycles (iii) Refrigerators/Air conditions (iv) Radios/radiograms/Television set and any other articles, the value of which individually exceeds Rs 1,0000/- (d) Value of items of moveable property individually worth less than Rs.10000/- other than articles of daily use such as clothes, books, utensils, beels cookery etc. added together as lumpsum.

2) (Rule 18(3) under CSS (Conduct) Rules, 1964): "Where a government servant enters into a transaction in respect of moveable property either in his own name or in the name of the member of his family, he shall, within one month from the date of such transaction, report the same to the prescribed authrhority, if the value of such property exceeds two month's basic pay in the case of a Government servant holding any Class I or Class II post or fifteen thousand rupees in the case of Government servant holding any Class III or Class IV post". The same should be reported in Prescribed Form 2 under Appendix V of CSS(Conduct) Rules, 1964.
