NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by article 162 read with proviso to article 309 of the constitution of India and in terms of the proviso to Rule 8, Rule 12(2)(a)&(b) and Rule 29(1)(vi) of the CCS(CCA) Rules, 1965 the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make order to specify competent authorities who are to exercise powers in appropriate manner as enumerated in the Schedule appended hereto in relation to Appointment to the State service under the Government of Mizoram and Disciplinary proceedings against the delinquent Government servants of the State of Mizoram to impose adequate penalties specified in Rule 11 of the CCS(CCA) Rules, 1965 commensurate with the offence committed upon the Govt. servant who is found guilty of the charge against him without prejudice any provisions of the rules ibid and the Government of Mizoram (Transaction of Business) Rules, 1987 as amended from time to time with immediate effect.
